

Anna Globe

This scholarship was established to honor the memory of Anna Globe, age 98, who died December 25, 2018, in Atlanta, GA. Born in Pinsk, Poland on August 23, 1920, Anna was a survivor of the Auschwitz concentration camp during the Holocaust.

On April 12, 1940, Anna married Jonas Globe and moved to Italy. They had one daughter, Betty, and eventually settled in Tulsa, OK. Without any knowledge of the English language but wanting to help her family, Anna used the skills she had and spent her early career as a seamstress. With education of paramount importance, Anna later received a Master's degree and eventually influenced hundreds of children as a Russian and German teacher for over 40 years. Anna was an active member of her synagogue, and the local Jewish community.

She was an avid reader and cherished time with her grandchildren and greatgrandchildren.
